In the area of Fine Motor, Candee has improved her cutting skills by holding the paper by herself with little assistance. In the area of Self-shelp, we are working on toileting, but Candee has not made much progress in this area--she still needs physical prompting throughout the entire process. In the area of Gross Motor, we worked on jumping, pushing, and climbing at tshе park. In the area of social skills, we are working on sharing toys with peers--she still needs verbal prompts, but she doesn't throw a tantrum anymore. Candee made a lot of good progress this month, but I'm concerned about her play skills. Candee would probably benefit from a wider variety of toys from the resource library because there aren't very many toys at home.
