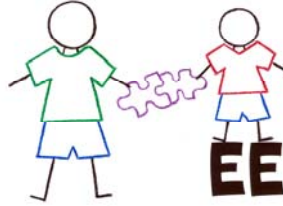


# Exceptional Expectations, L.L.C.

## Training Agreement

All Independent Contractors who provide habilitation services for Exceptional Expectations, L.L.C. are required to attend three hours of Continuing Education activities (i.e., workshop, seminar, conference, inservice) annually in order to maintain active status as an Independent Contractor. Service Providers may attend CE trainings hosted by Exceptional Expectations, L.L.C. and its staff, as well as opportunities provided by other agencies, institutions, etc. If the Independent Contractor would like to earn credit for educational opportunities provided by outside sources, a certificate of attendance and description of course content must be submitted prior to approval. Course content must specifically relate to working with children with special needs, including assessment, programming and treatment. Continuing Education training dates, times and topics will be listed monthly in the company newsletter and posted on the company website. It is the responsibility of the Service Provider to register in advance. Service Providers may attend as many CE trainings as desired. Service Providers will be reimbursed for attendance to CE trainings hosted by Exceptional Expectations, L.L.C. Failure to complete this requirement in a twelve (12) month period may result in a delay or denial of pay raise.
